- 1. Australia produces 4% of the world's beef and 8% of the lamb and mutton that is consumed globally.¹
- 2. There are around 50 different breeds of cattle and 40 different breeds of sheep in Australia.
- 3. Answers may include: manage livestock numbers, store produce in good seasons, monitor weather and match the correct breed with the appropriate climate.
