Answers will vary but may include:

Differences – outer covering differences (type, texture and colour), size and shape differences, face and ear shapes, and sounds made by the animal.

Similarities – farm animals, mammals, need food, water, air, and shelter to survive, herbivores, cared for by farmers, colour variations, hooves, found in groups or herds, used for meat.
